LONE DRY AGENT ON VISIT TO HOBOKEN

A lone Federal prohibition agent visited Hoboken yesterday afternoon and raided a house at 67 Willow avenue, where he arrested one man whom he charged with operating a still and brewing apparatus, and confiscated the machine.

Charles Riordan, 28, of 126 Garden street, Hoboken, the man arrested, was arraigned yesterday before United States Commissioner Edward R. Stanton and sent to the Hudson County jail in default of \$2,500 bail.

Federal Agent Sebastian La Sicola who made the raid, also arrested a Jersey City man whom he charged with sale and possession of intoxicating liquors at 933 Bevan street, Jersey City.

That was Rock Broskoske, 74, of 36 Concord street, Jersey City, who was also sent to the county jail in default of \$1,000 bail set by Commissioner Stanton. Broskoske, it was brought out at the hearing, has never become a citizen of this country though he has been in America for thirty-seven years. He is employed as a bartender at the Bevan street address.

A warrant was also issued for the arrest of Stanley Dunag, reputed to be the owner of the place. Prohibition agent La Sicola said he purchased a drink of whiskey there for fifty cents.
