

THREE RAID'S HERE

Hoboken, Bayonne and Union City Visited and Beer Is Seized.

Prohibition agents raided the saloon of Frank Vezzetti at 94 Hudson street, Hoboken, yesterday and, according to Walter Brown, deputy prohibition commissioner, obtained a quantity of liquor. The agents were seen also to go into the premises conducted by Vezzetti at 93 Hudson street, but there are no records at prohibition headquarters at Newark that a raid was conducted there.

The saloon at 94 Hudson street is a new place opened some time ago by Vezzetti and extends through to Court street and has a sixty foot bar. A large crowd watched the operations of the agents as they removed confiscated beer and liquor.

Another raid made by the Federal Officers yesterday was at the saloon of Joseph Cahill at 467 Communipaw avenue, Jersey City, where a quantity of liquor was seized.

At 4 o'clock this morning prohibition agents seized two stills on Forty-second street, Bayonne, according to Deputy Brown, but no details of the raid were available.
